Designed and co-taught an intensive, two week course covering non-toxic printmaking methods, including relief, monoprint, bookmaking and multi-media techniques.

CORE Interdisciplinary Laboratory (Fall 2015 and Spring 2016)

Led a foundational course and environment for investigating concepts and principles of three-dimensional visual organization, color, and design. Designed course content, syllabus and projects which move through media and spatial transitions, exploring a hybrid and inter-dimensional approach.

Intaglio Printmaking (Winter 2016)

Designed course in etching-focused investigation of the print process. Projects included softground, multiple-plate printing, chine-colle and print collage techniques.

Introduction to Printmaking (Spring 2015)

Led an introductory course which provides a historical framework for printmaking as well as foundational skills in screenprint and intaglio processes.

Beginning Drawing (Winter 2015)

Led introductory course exploring the conceptual and physical process of drawing designed to develop a basic mark-making skill set, including line, contour, value, gesture, perspective, and observed proportion. Projects explored inter-media and inter-dimensional shifts possible within drawing, allowing students to negotiate and question the boundaries of drawing.

Print Media Digital Arts lab sections (Spring and Fall 2014)

Led digital lab sections in basic introduction to Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop, and InDesign. Lectures and demonstrations developed basic understanding of formal and technical methodologies and how these shape visual qualities of screen- and print-based work.
